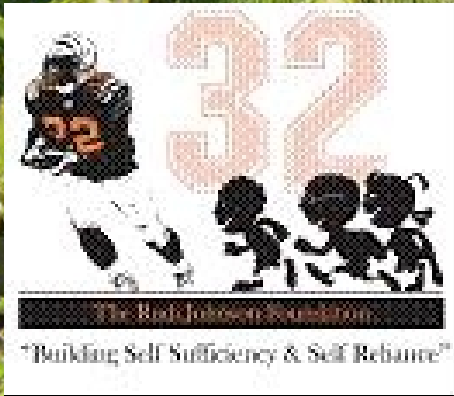

#32 Rudi Johnson...Cincinnati Bengals

Position: Running Back

Draft: 2001, 5th pick in Round 4 with Cincinnati Bengals

Personal: Son of Janice Johnson and Melvin Pegram and born in Et-trick, Virginia. He averaged 2,224 yards (7.3 average) for a total of 35 TDs in 1999 alone and named MVP of JC Championship game rushing for 373 yards and scoring all seven Butler TDs. Then he transferred to Auburn University where he finished with a school record-setting single season record for a second-most school history 1,567 yards. He had ten games with 100 yards or more. In 2000, he was named Southeastern Conference Player of the Year and earned Associated Press SEC Offensive Player of the Year honors. He entered draft as a junior.

Professional: . Johnson had 957 yards and 9 TDs in his first starting role in 2003 and then set a franchise record in the following season with 1,454 yards and 12 touchdowns. Named to 2004 AFC Pro Bowl team. Last season played in 11 games for 170 carries for 497 yards and 3 TDs.

Personal: Son of Rebecca and James born in Petersburg, Virginia. He was a Parade All-American as a senior, selected first team FB and LB, earned All-Metro and All-State honors. Earned *The Richmond Times-Dispatch* co-Player of the Year after posting 78 tackles, 11 sacks, five blocked kicks, four forced fumbles, and two interceptions. Also, had 105 carries for 1,006 yards (9.6 average) and 22 TDs. Furthermore had 19 receptions for 340 yards (17.9 average) and four TDs as a senior FB. Earned All Metro, All District, and All Region honors as a junior and lettered three times in football, track, and basketball. Was a three-year starter / four-year letterman and All-ACC First Team as a SR at UVA.

Professional: . Started in all 17 games last season totaling 94 tackles and 6.5 sacks. Has a career total of 798 tackles, 21 sacks, and 10 interceptions, was a 2004 Pro Bowl selection, and a Super Bowl Champion.

Personal: Born in St. Louis, Missouri where he earned four varsity letters in football, three in track, two in basketball, and one in baseball. Named MVP twice in basketball and place third in all-state track meet in 200-meter dash as a senior. Still holds single season rushing record at NSHS with 1,903 in 2002. At UM, he made school history as he rushed for 1,000 yards in each of his first three seasons. Total 3,933 yards earned him to be named a two-time All-Big Ten First Team Selection. Was selected by All-American in 2005. by Pro Football Weekly and Rivals.com

Professional: . Last season in 13 games, he had 185 carries for 835 rushing yards in an undefeated regular season by New England. Two games prior to loss in Super Bowl XLII, he had 244 yards and two TDs.

Personal: Born in Victor Valley, California. Had two seasons with Cerritos College Falcons in 1997 and 1998 in which he was a two-time First Team Mission Conference selection at WR and as a kickoff Returner. He finished with 1,152 receiving yards and 65 receptions. In addition, he had two 100-yard kickoff returns and an 87 yard punt return. From there he went on to OSU, where he started to catch 42 passes for 656 yards and six touchdowns.

Professional: . He had a modest rookie season recording 21 receptions for 228 yards; of which he set a franchise record for 126 punt return yards against Cleveland Browns. Last season he set a franchise record 112 receptions for 1,143 yards and 12 touchdowns. His 112 catches tied him with Wes Welker for the most ever in the NFL. In addition, he was selected to the Pro Bowl.

Professional: . Smith has accumulated 13 starts in a total of 49 games played. Last season he started in a career high 11 out of 15 games played for a total of 62 tackles and two sacks.

In NY at Henniger High School, he averaged 25 points, 18 rebounds, and 8 blocks per game to lead team to a 20—5 record. Then he transferred to South Kent Prep (CT) where he averaged 27.5 points, 16 rebounds, and 6 blocks per game to lead his team to a .

Professional: In the 2008 playoffs, in six games he averaged 3.7 points, 3.3 rebounds, and 1.0 blocks per game. In the regular season, in he started in 15 of 82 games played in which he averaged 7.5 points, 5.2 rebounds, and 1.4 blocks per game.

Personal: Son of Delphina Addison and was born in Washington, D.C. In high school, he was named Washington Post All Met Basketball Player of the Year for his averages of 20.2 points, 6.5 rebounds, 3.9 assists, and 3.1steals per game. He scored double figures in all but one game his senior season including a performance of 22 points and 8 rebounds in the Maryland 4A Championship. Also, at SJU before entering the draft after his junior year, he helped lead the Hawks to a perfect 27—0 where he averaged 23 points, 9.7 assists, and 71% three-point percentage.

Professional: Helped team advance to semi-finals of which, in six games he averaged 10.8 points per game, 3.3 rebounds, and 4.2 assists. After trade to Cleveland, he started in all 26 games played to average 10.3 points, 3.7 rebounds, and 4.5 assists per game.

He was All-ACC First Team 2003—2004, All-ACC Third Team 2004-2005, and voted to All-ACC Rookie Team 2002—2003.

Professional: . In the past season, he averaged 14.9 points, 2.7 rebounds, and 2.2 assists per game.

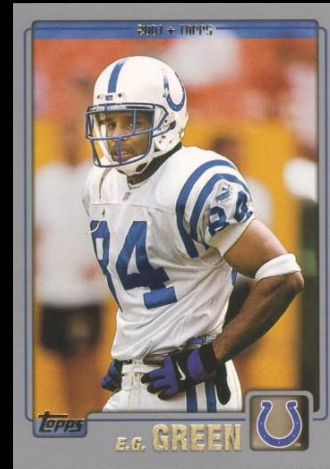

At the University of Georgia saw extensive playing time during the season as a sophomore in 2000; including in Georgia's 37 –14 win over Virginia in Oahu Bowl and then in Music City Bowl in 2001. In his senior year, he helped Bulldogs win a school record 13 games including victories in the SEC Championship and the 2003 Nokia Sugar Bowl. He was elected to 2003 Senior Bowl and the NCAA's post-season all-star game.

Professional: . Started all 16 games in 2004 to help Denver set franchise record allowing only 15 sacks and advance to 2005 AFC West Championship game. Traded to Detroit Lions on March 1, 2007 along with teammate Tatum Bell. Started in 9 of 15 games.

Personal: Born in Fort Walton Beach, Florida. In high school, he was Super Prep & USA Today All-American selection. Played as RB and Split End in FL/GA All-State game. At FSU, in 1997 held school record in TD catches, was only 2nd player in school history to gain over 1,000 yards receiving in a season twice, All-ACC 2nd team in 1996 and played in Sugar Bowl. Also, All-ACC 2nd team in 1995 as he had one TD and five catches in Orange Bowl.

Professional: . In debut season, he had 15 receptions for 177 yards (11.8 average) and one touchdown. In 1999, he played in 11 games for 21 receptions and 287 yards. In his final year, he played in only five games for 18 receptions and 201 yards and one touchdown.

Personal: Son of Harry and Pauline Sharper and born in Richmond, VA. He is the older brother of Minnesota Vikings safety, Darren Sharper. During his senior year in high school, he led with over 1,000 yards rushing and led a defense that held six District opponents to combined total of 10 points. He finished the University of Virginia as the school's all-time leading tackler.

Professional: . He was with the Baltimore Ravens from 1997 to 2001. In his debut year with the Ravens, he made a major impact collecting 68 tackles, three sacks, and one interception. He aided the Ravens in winning Super Bowl XXXV over the New York Giants, 34—7. It was the city's first super bowl in 30 years and they became the third team in Super Bowl history to shutout an opponent's offense; as the seven points scored was via special teams. From there, he was with the Houston Texans from 2002—2004 in which he led the NFL in tackles for that period with 301 tackles. His career season high tackles was 107 with the Texans. Sharper spent his 2005 season with the Seattle Seahawks where he had 29 tackles in eight games. During his nine year career, he had 882 tackles, 25.5 sacks, and 2 interceptions. He did not miss a game until his final season leaving him playing 128 straight games.

Personal: Born in New Orleans, Louisiana. In high school, he lettered in football, basketball, and baseball. He was All-State as a senior with 131 tackles and 13 sacks. At Georgia Tech, he was All-ACC first team as a sophomore in 2003 and All-ACC second team in 2004 and 2005. Also, he set a record with 59.5 tackles for loss and ranks fourth in school history with 25 sacks. In 2006, he played in the East-West Shrine game in San Antonio, Texas. He missed seven games in his final two collegiate seasons.

Professional: After rigorous preseason play, a dislocated wrist prevented him from playing in the regular season.
